Founded in 1970 as the Fraser Civic Chorus by Howard C. Richards, the Chorale has always been dedicated to providing audiences with beautiful vocal music and to educating and enriching the community. In 1975, Pasquale Pascaretti took up the baton and began transforming a typical community choir into Macomb County's premier chorus. The Chorale has performed the works of Schubert, Mozart, Bach, Vivaldi, Bernstein, The Beatles, Andrew Lloyd Webber, and many more. In recent years, MDC brought the music of contemporary composers, notably John Rutter and Karl Jenkins, to its audiences. On four occasions (2001, 2003, 2007, and 2018), the Chorale has performed at Carnegie Hall and has also premiered three works by Karl Jenkins for Michigan audiences. Now in its 54th season, the Chorale continues its mission of "Bringing music to life and lives to music!"
